

Sermon Questions – April 14, 2024
Witness - Luke 24:36-48

Warm Up Questions

Have you ever had to testify in court? If so, what did you witness that you had to testify to? Did you know all the answers to the questions? How did it make you feel?

Have you ever given your testimony in church or other setting of how Jesus changed your life? Is it an easy thing to do or difficult? Why? Do you have something prepared to say if someone asks you for a testimony?

Content Questions

When does this passage take place? Who were gathering together and where were they?

Why were they terrified when Jesus stood among them?

What does Jesus offer as proof to them that he is not what they say he is?

What does Jesus ask for when they had seen his proof? What does he do with it?

What does Jesus explain to them about the Law, the prophets and psalms? Why was that important?

What did Jesus tell them that they are to do with all these things he has taught them?

Application Questions

What is the significance of being able to touch Jesus and seeing Jesus eat? What does that say about what our lives will be like when we are resurrected?

What stories do you have about Jesus being alive and active in your life and in the world? What sorts of things are you witness to and have you ever told anyone about your story with Jesus?

Do you have to know all the answers when you are a witness? Why or why not? What does that mean about being a witness to Jesus? Do you know all the answers about Jesus?
